

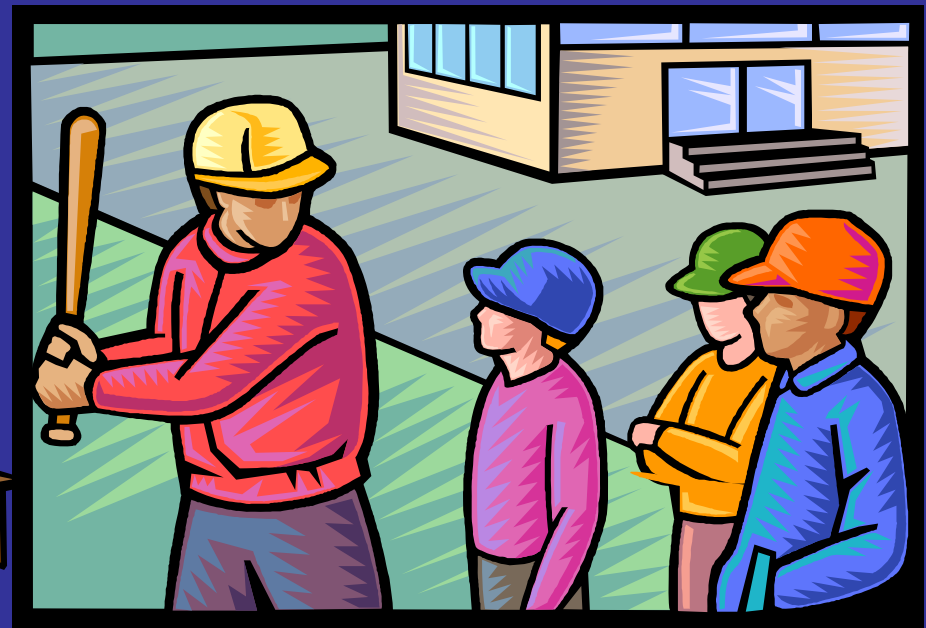
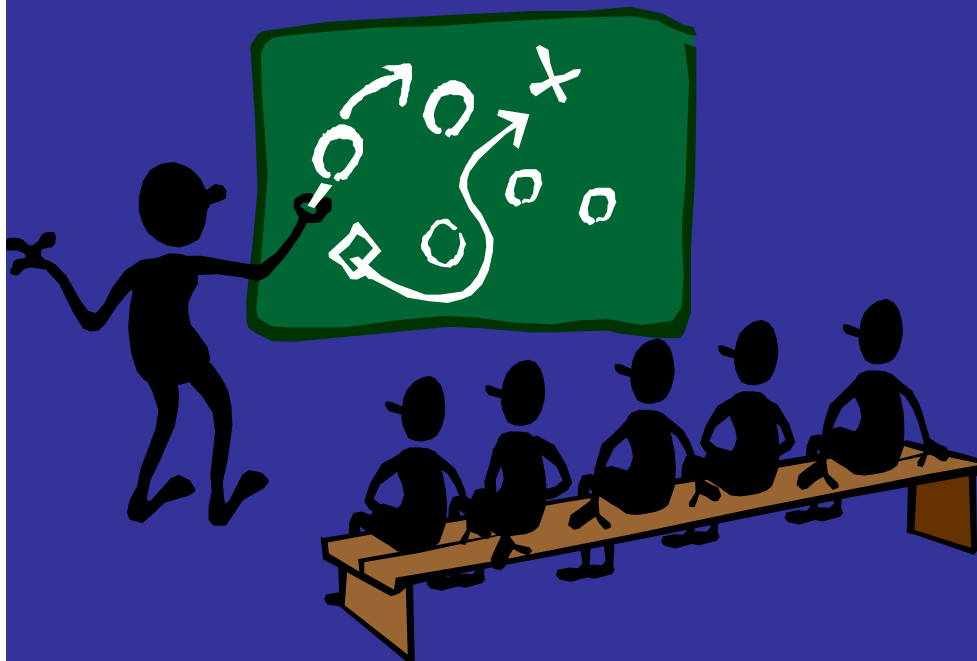

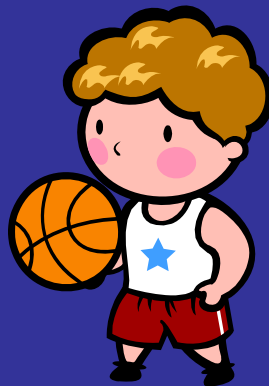
Players need chastening *AND* encouragement
(Hebrews 12:5-6, John 8:6-11)



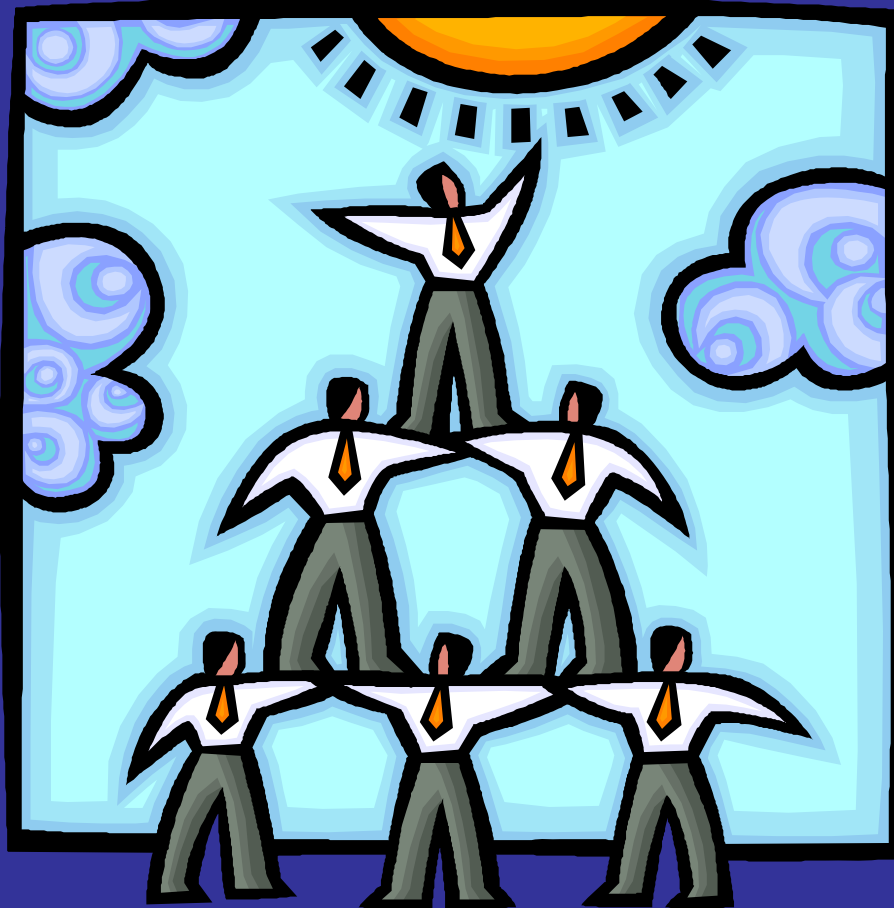

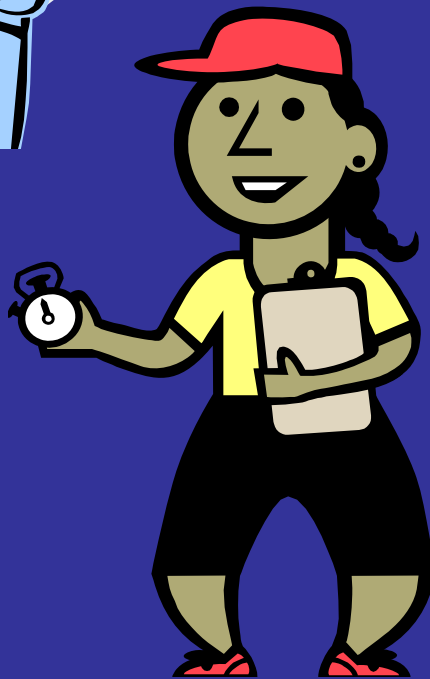
**Teamwork is critical for
